Assignment Title: Consultancy Services to establish “Meghalaya Road Asset Management System” On the Meghalaya State Road network under the World Bank Meghalaya Integrated Transport Project (MITP).

Government of Meghalaya has received a loan from the World Bank (IBRD) under its Meghalaya Integrated Transport Project (MITP) and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The Meghalaya Infrastructure Development and Financing Corporation (MIDFC) through Meghalaya Public Works Department (Roads), wish to establish a Road Asset Management System (RAMS) to significantly improve state road network planning for both capital and maintenance (Plan and Non-Plan) budgets. The RAMS is envisaged as a system which will eventually serve all levels in the PWD (Roads) department, i.e. headquarters, Circle and Division offices, in planning and managing the state road network.

The core of the system will be a Road Information System (RIS) that will include road inventory, condition, and traffic data, around which several applications will be developed/configured to address the various requirements of road planning, management, and monitoring.

The overall objective of the proposed services is to ensure that PWD (Roads) is able to effectively plan and prioritize their capital and maintenance works for 14,123KMs of road network for efficient use of resources. This will help to improve the quality and delivery of department's services in the provision and management of the road system.

The Meghalaya Public Works Department (Roads), Government of Meghalaya now invites eligible consulting firms (“Consultants”) to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The short listing criteria are:

- Experience of the consulting firm should be a minimum of 5 years. Prime Bidder should be a Consultant and Service provider Company/Partnership/ Proprietary firm since last 5 (five) years.
- Turn-over of the existing firm of last 5 consecutive financial year, from the year of REOI.
- Consultant must have good understanding of Government domain and must have successfully developed and implemented at least 2(two) Road Asset Management Project covering a road network of at least 10,000 (Ten Thousand) Kilometers for any Government Organization/PSU during the last 5 years.

- Qualifications and Experience of the key personnel of the consultancy firm.
- The Consultant should demonstrate that they have experience in consultancy engagement on development of RAMS system on As-is assessment, gap analysis of the existing RMS, RAMS strategy, action plan, institutional strengthening, and Implementation COTS (Custom of the Shelf). The Consultant must have developed such projects and completed within last 5 (five) years.
- Consultant (Prime or Consortium partner individually) must have completed road network condition survey of at least 10,000 (Ten Thousand) kilometer of undivided carriageway using network survey vehicle (NSV) equipment.
- Data acquisition on road condition with latest state of the art survey equipment's for 5,000 Kms.
- Two (2) completed/ substantially completed projects in IT Solution implementation for Government/ Public Sector Undertaking (PSU), each of minimum value of 5 Crore. Those firms having implemented the IT solution for Roads / Civil Infrastructure in Government/ Public Sector Undertaking (PSU) shall be given preference.
- Experience of working in hilly terrain shall be given preference.
- Experience in handling externally aided projects with the World Bank/ADB and or other multilateral financing agencies shall be given preference.

The TOR for the activity is also enclosed.

The employer intends to engage the services of a consultant for the aforementioned works.

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to paragraph 3.17 of the World Bank's *Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers, July 2016- Revised November 2017 and August 2018* as amended from time to time [under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants] by the World Bank Borrowers, setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.

Consultants may associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture or a sub consultancy to enhance their qualifications.

A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) method set out in the Consultant Guidelines of the World Bank.
